We will review your application within 2 weeks and let you know if there are any changes that need to be made. If your application is selected we will let you know when your Featured Artist story will be featured on our website. Featured Artists will also be included in our Discover Brantford blog and social media.

For you to be a Featured Artist, we require you to submit a minimum of two <u>HIGH QUALITY</u> (minimum of 1200px wide) photographs of yourself and/or your art. These photographs can include examples of you making or participating in your art form, works-in-progress or completed projects, your studio, tools of the trade, etc. Your photos should be emailed as attachments in .jpg format when you submit this application

Ideally, we request that you send us:

- 2-3 photos of you, including you taking part in your artistic endeavour
- 2-3 photos of your projects, spaces, tools, etc.
- *please submit large format jpg photos (min. 1200px wide) as these will look best. If you have any questions email culture@brantford.ca

IMPORTANT: You must have the right to use and share the photos that you submit, and provide photo credits where necessary. By submitting these photos, you grant permission for them to be posted online as part of the Featured Artist blog post and feature.
