IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PUPPY RATE: A new dog 6 months of age or under will be charged the altered rate in the initial licensing year. To receive the altered rate thereafter, compliance with Section 206.6.4.1 Licence fee – altered dog, is required.(Proof of altering is required from a licensed veterinarian.)

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF DOGS PERMITTED:

Section 206.2.1 of the City of Brantford Municipal Code states “no more than 3 domestic dogs of an age in excess of six months shall be kept, harboured, maintained or possessed at any location within the City of Brantford”.

BRANT SPCA (BSPCA) INFORMATION: All licence fees collected are used to help offset the cost of the contract between the City of Brantford and the BSPCA for enforcement of the Animal Control By-law. BSPCA officers are on duty 7 days a week, 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. The enforcement includes but is not limited to:

- Ensuring dog owners comply with the City’s licensing requirements
- Ensuring owner compliance with the special requirements for restricted, dangerous and potentially dangerous dogs
- Investigating complaints including dog running-at-large, aggressive dog behaviour or dog bite incidents
- Ensuring any Prohibited Animal is removed from the City (see Bylaw for a complete listing)
- Prosecution support related to by-law infractions
- Impounding of animals
- Emergency Services – injured animals – assistance to Police Department and Brant County Health Unit
- Removal of dead carcass (small animals only on Municipal Property within 12 hours of notification (No skunks or large animals such as deer).
