NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION SESSION

BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BRANTFORD & COUNTY OF BRANT

The Council of the City of Brantford will hold a Public Information Session on May 8, 2007, pursuant to Section 173 (3) of the Municipal Act, S.O., 2001, to receive input from the public on the proposed boundary adjustment and restructuring between the County of Brant and the City of Brantford.

The area of the boundary adjustment involves the following approximate areas:

- 2378 hectares north of the existing City boundary to Governors Road (Highway 5 and 99) from Paris Road eastward to approximately 3 km east of Park Road North, as well as an area east of the Lynden Hills neighbourhood
- 159 hectares east of Garden Avenue and north of the Highway 403
- 12 hectares west of Mount Pleasant Street and south of Hogarth Road and Cooper Court.

A map showing the location of the subject properties as well as details contained in a letter of intent between the City and the County outlining the proposed terms of the boundary change are available for viewing at the Planning Department, 2nd Floor, Brantford City Hall, and on the City's website, www.brantford.ca.

All interested parties are invited to attend the Public Information Session and any person who attends the meeting may make representations relating to the proposed restructuring. The meeting will be held on:
