November 8, 1920

Canadian Mausoleum Co. representative addresses Council.

February 26, 1923

Resolution of Council

“**THAT** the communication of the Canadian Mausoleum Company Limited be referred to the Building and Grounds Committee.”

February 26, 1923

Building/Grounds Report to Council

“**YOUR** Committee on Building and Grounds recommend that the offer of The Canadian Mausoleum Company Limited dated February 19, 1923 to erect a Mausoleum in Brantford, be accepted.”

November 5, 1923

Bylaw No. 1820

AN agreement was ratified which confirmed the responsibility of care & maintenance of the Mausoleum to The Corporation of the City of Brantford.
