HOUSING RESOURCE CENTRE



For Tenants

The Housing Resource Centre provides help to find and keep suitable and affordable living conditions by offering:

- * A listing of available apartments, townhomes, and houses in the private market.
- * Basic information on the Tenant
- * Advocacy for tenants with housing issues.

For Landlords

The program assists landlords in finding tenants for rooms, apartments, or houses by providing:

- * Free advertising of vacant units
- * Referring prospective tenants to the landlords advertisements
- * Providing information on landlord responsibilities.

Outreach Program

This program helps individuals and families who are homeless by:

- * Providing time-limited shelter
- * Providing support, advocacy, and case management services
- * Referring clients to available resources, food programs, temporary and permanent housing, and other needed services available in the community.

Outreach services are offered to those who demonstrate a willingness to develop and follow through with a plan that will lead to being an independent member of this community.

Rent Bank

This program provides mediation and/or loans to qualified tenants who are at risk of losing their housing due to shelter arrears.

To qualify for the rent bank, you must:

- * Be a tenant 16 years or older
- * Not be in debt to the Rent Bank
- * Be able to afford the rent and utilities where you live
- * Have an eviction notice (N4)
- * Be able to repay the loan
- * Not be getting evicted for any other reason
- * No more than 2 months in arrears

Rent Geared to Income (RGI) tenants are not eligible for Rent Bank funds.
