## TRAIL ACCESS POINTS

Most access points have kiosks and all have some parking. The trail may also be accessed at various points of interest and other locations noted on the map with the symbol **P**.

- A MASTERS LANE**  
Location: end of Master's Lane, off Oak Park Rd.  
Parking: 12 cars  
Kiosk, access to the Paris/Cambridge Rail Trail.

- B WILKES DAM**  
Location: Dufferin Ave., at Parkside Dr.  
Parking: 8 cars  
Kiosk, interpretive loops, views.  
**P**
- C WATERWORKS PARK**  
Location: off Grand River Ave. beside the P.U.C. service depot.  
Parking: 50 cars  
Kiosk, interpretive loops, picnic tables and shelter, natural area.  
**P**
- D MORRELL STREET**  
Location: end of Morrell St. at Grand River Ave.  
Parking: 5 cars  
Kiosk.

- E EARL HAIG FAMILY FUN PARK**  
Location: Market Street at Erie Ave.  
Parking: 50 cars  
Kiosk, washrooms, swimming.  
**P**
- F GREENWICH STREET**  
Location: off Greenwich St. at Mohawk St.  
Parking: 40 cars  
Close to Mohawk Chapel and Kanata Village, access to Hamilton Rail Trail.

- G LOCKS ROAD/BEACH ROAD**  
Parking: 5 cars (roadside)  
Close to historic ruins, access to Hamilton Rail Trail.

- H LIONS PARK**  
Location: along Gilkison Street  
Parking: 50 cars at Lions Park Arena, additional roadside parking.  
Kiosk, interpretive loops, picnic tables and shelter, natural area, washrooms and phone at arena.

- I LORNE PARK / FORDVIEW PARK**  
Parking: 25 cars  
Location: beside Lorne Park across Colborne St. W. More parking off Gilkison St.. at Fordview Court.  
Interpretive panels, map, sponsor recognition, gardens.

- J D'AUBIGNY CREEK PARK**  
Location: off Ballantyne Dr., past Cockshutt Park.  
Parking: 25 cars.  
Kiosk, soccer fields, canoe launch, natural area.

- K D'AUBIGNY CREEK PARK**  
Location: off Colborne St. W. at Oakhill Dr.  
Parking: 50 cars  
Kiosk, soccer fields, picnic tables, natural area.

- L D'AUBIGNY CREEK PARK**  
Location: off Colborne St. W. at Oakhill Dr.  
Parking: 10 cars  
National historic site, washrooms, Grand Valley Trail, picnic area, seasonal restaurant.

- M BELL HOMESTEAD**  
Location: Tutela Heights Rd.  
Parking: 10 cars  
National historic site, washrooms, Grand Valley Trail, picnic area, seasonal restaurant.

- N MOHAWK PARK**  
Parking: 25 cars off Forest Rd., additional parking in park.  
Views, washrooms, picnic tables & pavilion, children's playground, splash pad.

- O LORNE PARK / FORDVIEW PARK**  
Parking: 25 cars  
Location: beside Lorne Park across Colborne St. W. More parking off Gilkison St.. at Fordview Court.  
Interpretive panels, map, sponsor recognition, gardens.

- P BRANT'S CROSSING / CIVIC CENTRE**  
Location: off Market Street, behind Civic Centre  
Parking: 50+ cars  
Trans Canada Trail Pavilion (sponsor recognition), lookout, washrooms, close to downtown, casino.

- Q EARL HAIG FAMILY FUN PARK**  
Location: Market Street at Erie Ave.  
Parking: 50 cars  
Kiosk, washrooms, swimming.

Parking: 25 cars.  
Kiosk, soccer fields, canoe launch, natural area.

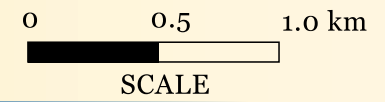
