RECYCLABLE MATERIALS INCLUDE:

PLACE IN THE RECYCLING TOTE MARKED: PLASTIC/METAL OR GLASS CONTAINERS

PLACE IN THE RECYCLING TOTE MARKED: NEWSPAPER JUNKMAIL BOXBOARD



PLASTIC CONTAINERS:
(Clear plastic such as water bottles)



PLASTIC CONTAINERS:
(Heavier plastic such as detergent bottles)



PLASTIC CONTAINERS:
(Rigid plastic such as ice cream tubs)

WAXED CARTONS:
(Milk/Juice cartons and drinking boxes-*remove screw top plastic lids*)



GLASS:
(Clear or coloured glass used for food or beverages)

METAL:
(Tin and aluminum cans)



ALUMINUM:
(We accept aluminum foil, plates and containers if clean)



NEWSPAPER:
(All newsprint including junk-mail)



PAPER:
(Computer paper, lined paper, envelopes with windows removed)

BOOKS:

(Magazines, telephone books, soft covered books)

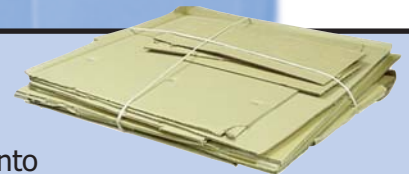


BOXBOARD:

(Cereal, detergent, tissue boxes. Paper rolls from wrapping paper, paper towel etc., all flattened)

CARDBOARD:

(Flatten and tie corrugated cardboard into 30"x30"x 8" bundles and set beside bin, not inside)



DO NOT RECYCLE *the following*

The City of Brantford Recycling Program does not accept the following items *at this time*:

PLASTIC SHOPPING BAGS

#6 BAKERY OR PRODUCE CONTAINERS

(BAKERY OR PRODUCE CONTAINERS ARE COMMONLY MADE FROM A #6 PLASTIC AND ARE NOT RECYCLABLE AT THIS TIME)

#4 PLASTIC BOTTLES

(#4 PLASTICS SUCH AS MUSTARD BOTTLES)

#3 & #7 PLASTICS ALSO NOT ACCEPTABLE AT THIS TIME.

FAST FOOD COFFEE CUPS

CERAMIC OR GLASS DISHES
(BROKEN OR NOT)

WAXED CARDBOARD ICE CREAM CONTAINERS

FAST FOOD TAKE OUT CONTAINERS
(STYROFOAM OR PLASTIC)

Household Hazardous Waste Information:

Bring your household hazardous wastes & tires to our "HHW" days!
("HHW" dates can be found on the environmental web site: www.brantford.ca/environmental)

Household Hazardous Waste Days provide an opportunity to discard unwanted pharmaceuticals, household cleaners, paints, paint cleaners, adhesives, wood preservatives, bug sprays, pesticides, lawn care products, propane tanks, propane cylinders, pool chemicals, driveway sealers, poisons, oils, oil filters, antifreeze, fuels, metal polishes, batteries (automotive & household). These kinds of wastes should not be thrown away with your regular garbage or poured down the drain where they could cause damage to the environment. We cannot accept: Industrial, Commercial & Institutional Waste

TIRES: Limit of 5 tires per vehicle per event day (Passenger, bicycle, motorcycle, camper trailer, off or on the rim). Not accepted: truck/trailer and off road tires, tires >16" in diameter.

RECYCLE YOUR OLD ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT: Bring your tired electronic equipment to the Household Hazardous Waste Days for recycling. The program is designed to keep this equipment out of the landfill. Simply bring your acceptable electronic equipment, *which includes:* personal computers (CPU, keyboard, mouse, monitor*), mini and mainframe computers and components, printers, scanners, drives and modems, cameras, telecommunications equipment, telephones (mobile/cellular/"hardwire"), fax machines, photocopiers and printing/plotting equipment, electronic calculators, microwave ovens, VCRs, DVD players, software (floppy disks, CDs, etc.), stereos.

***NOTE:** computer monitors will be recycled only if accompanied by a CPU (i.e. a complete computer package).

BRING US YOUR FLUORESCENT TUBES: Residents of Brantford can take fluorescent tubes to the Mohawk Street Landfill during Household Hazardous Waste Days. Fluorescent tubes contain mercury. Place tubes in a cardboard box or wrap them in newspaper. Do not tape tubes together. Limit of 10 tubes per vehicle per event day.
