Notice of Preliminary Engineering Site Work Downtown Streetscaping

Dear All Area Residents/Business Owners/Tenants/Agencies:

As part of the ongoing efforts by the City of Brantford to maintain and improve its infrastructure, the following streets has been identified for improvements. This is as part of Downtown Streetscaping project.

- Dalhousie St. From Brant Ave. to Clarence St.
- Colborne St. From Brant Ave. to Clarence St.
- Brant Ave., King St., Queen St., Market St., and Charlotte St. From Dalhousie St. to Colborne St.
- Bain St. and Echo St. From Colborne St. to Wharfe St.
- Wharfe St. From Bain St. to Echo St.

The first stage of the process is to accurately establish the existing conditions along and below the street by completing various field investigations. Over the next few months, City crews and/or its contractors will be on site to complete some or all of the following works:

• **Surveying** - to verify the existing features along the road and at the front or side of your property.



- Subsurface Utility Engineering (SUE) investigation to verify the existing features under the road.
- **Soil Testing** to identify the existing underground soil and water conditions for the design and construction of the infrastructure.

Staff and the City's consultant will be following all Ontario Health and Safety measures while undertaking this work.
