Article 1 APPOINTMENT

148.1.1 City - defined

“City” means The Corporation of the City of Brantford.

148.1.2 Council - defined

“Council” means the Municipal Council for the City.

148.1.3 City of Brantford - defined

“City of Brantford” means the geographic region of the City of Brantford.

148.1.4 Municipal Weed Inspector - defined

“Municipal Weed Inspector” means municipal weed inspector as defined in the *Weed Control Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. W.5, as amended.

Article 2 MUNICIPAL WEED INSPECTORS

148.2.1 Municipal Weed Inspectors - authority to appoint

The appointment of Municipal Weed Inspectors shall be made by Council from time to time, upon recommendation of the Director of Parks.

148.2.2 Municipal Weed Inspectors – appointment

Rob Sawicki, Supervisor of Horticulture, Turf and Forestry Operations, and Laura Wright, Urban Forestry Technician, are hereby appointed as Municipal Weed Inspectors for the City of Brantford. (By-law 46-2016, 29 March 2016)

148.2.3 Municipal Weed Inspectors - powers

Municipal Weed Inspectors shall hold said office at the pleasure of Council and subject to the provisions of the *Weed Control Act* and shall exercise all authority, powers and rights thereof and shall perform all the duties and obligations which by statute or by-law are or may be conferred or imposed on Municipal Weed Inspectors.

148.2.4 Term - cease to be employees - appoint - successors

All appointments of Municipal Weed Inspectors shall be for the shorter of the following:

- (a) the duration of the Municipal Weed Inspector’s employment with the City; or
- (b) until the Municipal Weed Inspector’s successor is appointed.

148.2.5 Remuneration - regular salary

The regular salary of a Municipal Weed Inspector shall be considered sufficient remuneration for the duties performed by the Municipal Weed Inspector pursuant to this Chapter and the *Weed Control Act*.

Article 3
ENACTMENT

148.3.1 Effective date

This Chapter shall take effect from and after the date of passing of the enabling by-law. By-law 30-2014, 24 March, 2014; Schedule 'A'.
