Article 1

VETERANS - BRITISH EMPIRE - ENGAGEMENTS

229.1.1 Lots - set aside - soldiers' burying plot

Lot numbers 8, 9, 10 and 11 in Ranges 5, 6, 7 and 8 in section C East, in Mount Hope Cemetery, are hereby set apart as a soldiers' burying plot for the graves of veterans of the wars in which the British Empire has been engaged.

229.1.2 Burial - privilege of - application

Any soldiers' organization in the City of Brantford shall have the privilege of burial of any such soldier in the said soldiers' plot, upon application therefor being made to The Brantford Cemetery Commission.

229.1.3 Veteran - non-member - soldier organization

A veteran of any war in which the British Empire has been engaged and whose burial takes place, at the City of Brantford maybe buried in the soldiers' plot, whether such veteran shall or shall not have been a member of any soldiers' organization, upon application therefor being made to The Brantford Cemetery Commission.
