Article 1

ELDERLY PERSONS' CENTRE

239.1.1 Established - operation

An Elderly Persons' Centre shall be established and operated by the Corporation of the City of Brantford in accordance with the *Elderly Persons' Centres Act*, R.S.O. 1980, chapter 131, as amended, on the second floor at the Richard Beckett Building at 219 Colborne Street, Brantford.

239.1.2 Property - purchased - expenditures - authorized

The Corporation of the City of Brantford may acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise real and personal property for the purpose of operating and establishing the said centre, may enter into any agreements with other approved corporations with respect to the operation of the said Centre and is authorized to make such expenditure as are necessary for these purposes.

239.1.3 Authorization - Mayor - Clerk

The Mayor and Clerk shall be authorized to execute all documents necessary to give effect thereto.

Article 2**ENACTMENT - CONDITION****239.2.1 Approval - required**

This Chapter shall come into force and take effect upon the approval of the Ontario Minister of Community and Social Services given Pursuant to the *Elderly Persons' Centres Act*. By-law 153-84, 9 October, 1984.
