Chapter 365 LIQUOR LICENCE ACT - VOTING

Article 1 AUTHORIZED

365.1.1 Questions - submitted to vote

Article 2 DATE OF VOTE

365.2.1 Wednesday, January 13, 1960 - directed by LLBO

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 24 (1)(a) of the *Liquor Licence Act*, the Liquor Licence Board shall not issue a dining lounge or lounge licence to hotels, inns or taverns in any municipality in which such licences have not been issued heretofore to hotels, inns or taverns unless or until an affirmative vote has been taken on Questions 7 and 8 as set out in subsection 69(1) of the Act.

AND WHEREAS under section 69 of the Liquor Licence Act, the Council of a municipality may submit to a vote of the persons qualified to be entered on the voters' list and to vote at Elections to the Assembly in the municipality any questions set forth in subsection 69 (1) of the *Liquor Licence Act*.

AND WHEREAS it is also provided by section 69 of the Act that where a petition in writing signed by at least twenty-five per centum of the total number of persons appearing by the last revised list of the municipality to be resident therein and qualified to vote at elections to the Assembly requesting the Council to submit any question or questions set out in section 69 is filed with the Clerk of the Municipality and with the Board, the Council shall submit the question or questions to a vote of the electors.

AND WHEREAS a petition has been filed with the Clerk of the municipality requesting the Council to submit to a vote of the persons qualified to vote thereon the following questions:

Are you in favour of the sale of liquor under a dining lounge licence for consumption with meals on licensed premises?"

"Are you in favour of the sale of liquor under a lounge licence for consumption on licensed premises?"

AND WHEREAS the petition certified by the Clerk as having been sufficiently signed has been filed with the Board.

AND WHEREAS the Board has fixed Wednesday the 13th day of January, A.D. 1960, as the day upon which the vote upon the questions shall be taken and has notified the Clerk to that effect.

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient and desirable that the vote on the questions shall be taken upon the day above mentioned.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to provide by by-law for the submission of the questions to the persons qualified to vote thereon and for the taking of their votes thereon.

Article 1 AUTHORIZED

365.1.1 Questions - submitted to vote

Under the *Liquor Licence Act* there is hereby submitted to a vote of the persons qualified to be entered on the Voters' List and to vote at elections to the assembly in the municipality the following questions:

"Are you in favour of the sale of liquor under a dining lounge licence for consumption with meals on licensed premises?"

"Are you in favour of the sale of liquor under a lounge licence for consumption on licensed premises?"

Article 2 DATE OF VOTE

365.2.1 Wednesday, January 13, 1960 - directed by LLBO

The vote shall be taken on Wednesday the 13th day of January A.D. 1960, as directed by the Liquor Licence Board of Ontario. By-law 4145, 26 October, 1959.

Note: On January 13, 1960, a liquor licence vote was held and affirmative votes of 63.5% and 62.16% in favour of the sale of liquor under a dining lounge licence and under a lounge licence respectively took place.
