Article 1 INTERPRETATION

618.1.1 Motorized snow vehicle - defined

“motorized snow vehicle” means a self-propelled vehicle designed to be driven exclusively on snow or ice, or both.

618.1.2 Road allowance - defined

“road allowance” means that parcel of land vested in the Corporation of the City of Brantford for highway purposes and shall include the travelled portion thereof, sidewalks and boulevards.

Article 2 OPERATION - PROHIBITED

618.2.1 Driving - on road allowance - within City - prohibited

No person shall drive, or permit to be driven, any motorized snow vehicle along or across any road allowance, or part or parts thereof, under the jurisdiction of the City of Brantford, within the limits of the City of Brantford. By-law 149-72, 15 January, 1973; By-law 87-83, 20 June, 1983.

Article 3 ENFORCEMENT

618.3.1 Fine - for contravention

Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Chapter is guilty of an offence and shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay a penalty of not more than \$5,000, exclusive of costs and every such fine is recoverable under the *Provincial Offences Act*. Article 4 REPEAL - ENACTMENT - CONDITIONAL

618.4.1 By-law - previous

By-law 13-72 of the Corporation of the City of Brantford, is hereby repealed.

618.4.2 M.T.C. - approval - required

This Chapter shall not become effective until approved by the Ontario Ministry of Transportation and Communications. By-law 149-72, 15 January, 1973.

618.4.3 M.T.C. - approval - obtained
