## Article 1

INTERPRETATION

### 616.1.1 Downtown core - defined

"downtown core" is that area of the City of Brantford bounded by Nelson Street, Alfred Street, Colborne Street, The Ring Road, Brant Avenue and West Street.

### 616.1.2 Skateboard - defined

"skateboard" is defined to be the platform on small wheels used by a person or persons for transportation or play, commonly known as a skateboard.

## Article 2 <br> SKATEBOARDS

### 616.2.1 Prohibited - on roadway - in City

No person shall ride a skateboard on any paved roadway, excluding sidewalks, within the City of Brantford.

### 616.2.2 Prohibited - Downtown core

No person shall ride a skateboard on any paved roadway, including sidewalks, within the downtown core, in the City of Brantford.

## Article 3 <br> ENACTMENT

### 616.3.1 Ministry of Transportation - approval - required

This Chapter shall become effective upon the date of its passing, save and except that any provisions of this Chapter affecting traffic on highways designated as connecting links, pursuant to subsection 21(1) of the Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act, R.S.O. 1980, c. 421, as amended, shall not become operative until approval by the Ontario Ministry of Transportation. By-law 167-89, 4 July, 1989.

### 616.3.2 Ministry of Transportation - approval - received
