Article 1 INTERPRETATION

604.1.1 Person - defined

"person" means and includes persons, firms and corporations.

Article 2 GENERAL PROHIBITIONS

604.2.1 Obstruction - watercourse - drain - public highway No person shall obstruct any drain or watercourse situate on a public highway in the City of Brantford.

604.2.2 Installation - culvert - bridge - without licence

No person shall establish or install any culvert and/or bridge, which crosses any drain or watercourse situate on a public highway in the City of Brantford, without first having obtained a licence from the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brantford so to do.

Article 3 ESTABLISHED - INSTALLED

604.3.1 Licence - granted - subject to Council approval

Upon the granting of such licence, any person may establish and install such culvert and/or bridge, subject to the approval of the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brantford.

Article 4 COST - OF INSTALLATION

604.4.1 Culvert - under 20 feet - fee

Upon application by any authorized person, the Council may install a culvert having a length of twenty feet or less, for a charge of \$35.00, to include the cost of all excavation, culvert pipe, covering material and any other necessary work.

604.4.2 Culvert - over 20 feet - total cost to applicant

Any length of culvert over twenty feet in length required to serve one property, shall be charged wholly to the person applying for such culvert.

Article 5 ENACTMENT

604.5.1 Effective date

This Chapter shall come into force and effect on the passing thereof. By-law 3725, 7 May, 1956.
