- Enter in the Dog ID number (found on the front of the renewal notice)
- Enter the necessary payment information (please note the 2.75% renewal processing fee)
- A 2020 dog tag will be mailed to you

## **Additional Licensing Information**

If your dog has been spayed or neutered since purchasing your 2019 licence, please provide proof from a licensed Ontario Veterinarian in order to receive the corresponding fee.

Puppy Rate: a new dog 6 months of age or under will be charged the altered rate in the initial licensing year. Proof of alteration is required from a licensed Ontario veterinarian for renewals. (Compliance with Section 206.6.4.1 licence fee – altered dog, is required)

Licence fees help to offset the costs of the Animal Services Program:

- Animal Control and Pound Services
- Emergency Services – injured animals
- Carcass removal – small animals on Municipal Property
