Protocol for attending City facilities

Anyone entering a City facility will be required to answer health-screening questions by Building Security and sign in for the purposes of contact tracing at the door. Hand washing guidelines are to be followed and persons are to maintain a physical distance of 6 feet from others. All visitors will be required to wear a face covering at all times in City facilities as per the Mandatory Face Coverings in Public Spaces By-Law. If you do not have a face covering, one will be provided.

Please note, there is a limit to the number of visitors allowed inside at one time, and lines will be outside with appropriate markings for physical distancing.

Additional Licensing Information

If your dog has been spayed or neutered since purchasing your 2020 licence, please provide proof from a licensed Ontario Veterinarian in order to receive the corresponding fee.

Puppy Rate: a new dog 6 months of age or under will be charged the altered rate in the initial licensing year. Proof of alteration is required from a licensed Ontario veterinarian for renewals. (Compliance with Section 206.6.4.1 licence fee - altered dog, is required)

Who to Notify if Your Dog Passes Away

If you have a current dog licence and your pet has passed away, please let us know. Your record will be updated so that you will no longer receive licence reminders.
