

NHCF Projects in Ontario - Ownership

Habitat for Humanity - Peterborough

- 41 units homeownership
- 6 one-bedroom, 29 two-bedroom and 6 threebedroom units
- All units affordable (incomes from low \$20K to \$50K) depending on family size





NHCF Projects in Ontario - Affordable Rental

Allanview Place – Barrie

- The project will have 34 units in total, with the existing 23 units geared towards low-middle income families, and an additional 11 units geared towards seniors.
- 27 units will be affordable and will have rent representing less than 71% of the median market rent.
- 10 of the 11 new units for seniors will be fully accessible.
- The new building is expected to achieve energy savings and a reduction in greenhouse gas emissions of 35.9% over NECB 2015.

SEED Funding

Contributions or loans to assist with planning costs of building new affordable housing project or preserving existing community housing project.

New Construction support costs for completing pre-development activities

<u>Preservation</u> – Support costs for completing preservation activities



SEED Funding

ELIGIBILITY

- Community housing sector (non-profit housing organizations & rental co-ops)
- Municipal, provincial and territorial governments and their agencies
- Indigenous governments / organizations
- Private entrepreneurs / builders /developers

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

- Community and affordable housing
- Mix-use market/affordable rental
- Shelters, transitional & supportive housing
- Conversion of non-residential buildings to affordable multi-unit residential
- Renovation of existing affordable units at risk of being abandoned or demolished
- Indigenous community housing






Housing Suitability – CCEA Data

Housing suitability

Nearly two-thirds of Ontario residents are living in homes too big for their needs, leaving 5 million bedrooms empty. Even in Toronto, where the housing market is especially tight, there are two million empty bedrooms. Most of the people living in too-large homes are seniors. Percentage of households.


