
Housing Services Update

Reflections from the past / Forging the road ahead...







2002-2009

Context:

- Social Housing Reform Act
- new role Service Manager
- Federal-Provincial Community Rental Program (later the Canada-Ontario Affordable Housing Program)

By the numbers...

- 402 units built (16 projects)
- 83 households assisted for home ownership
- 123 households received rent supplements
- 65 households helped through RRAP (now Ontario Renovates)



2010-2019

Context:

- Housing Services Act, 2011
- 10-year housing & homelessness plans
- Integration of homelessness with housing
- System vs. program delivery
- Investment in Affordable Housing (later OPHI), COCHI, Home for Good


By the numbers...

- 117 units built (4 projects)
- 129 BHomes
- 383 households received rent supplements including the local portable benefit
- 195 households helped through Ontario Renovates






The road ahead - 2020 to 2029

Municipal Housing Master Plan

- Increase to City operated stock –
 506 units over 10 years
- Tied to growth projections & service levels of City owned stock
- Mapping & Assessment of Housing Need
- Prioritization criteria
- Integrate current asset management planning
- Dovetail with other strategies to leverage partnerships & resources





The road ahead - 2020 to 2029

CASE Homes & Emerging Alternative Building Options

- Small homes 280-350 sq ft
- Infill opportunities
- Emerging building and construction techniques – modular, container, moveable

- National Housing Strategy
 - Canada-Ontario Housing Benefit
 - Co-investment/Innovation Funds





- Legislative Changes
 - Simplification RGI calculation, wait list rules, reporting
