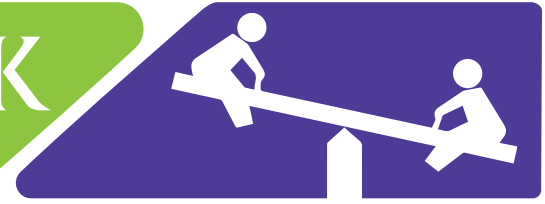
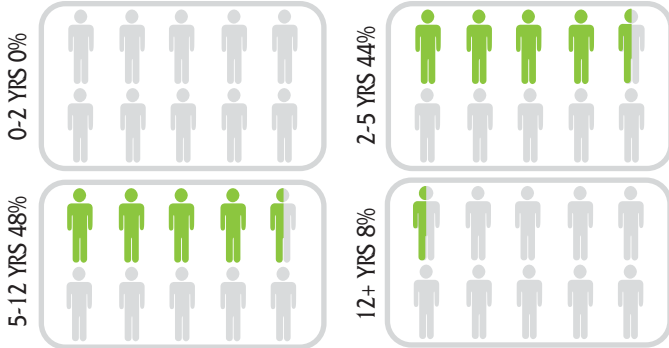

CURRENT PLAYGROUND USER AGE GROUPS

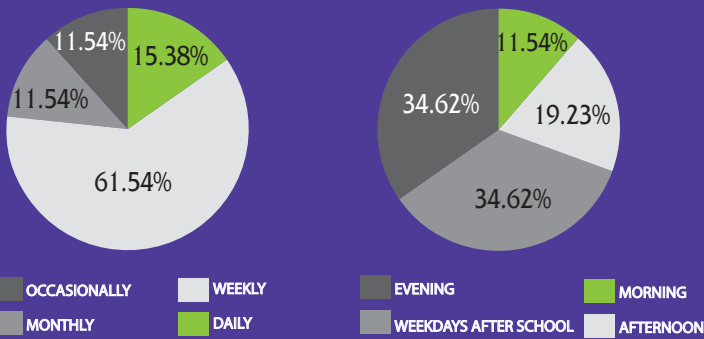


HOW PEOPLE CURRENTLY USE DEVON DOWN PARK

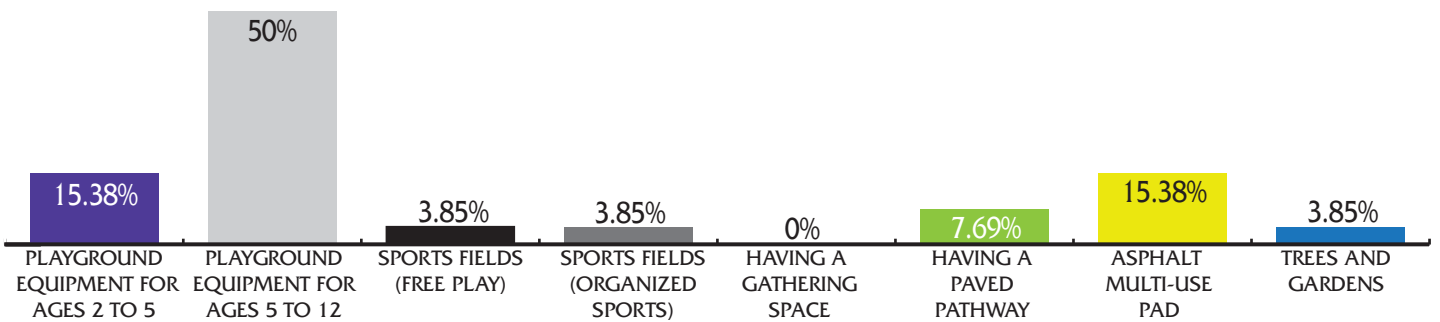


PARK USAGE

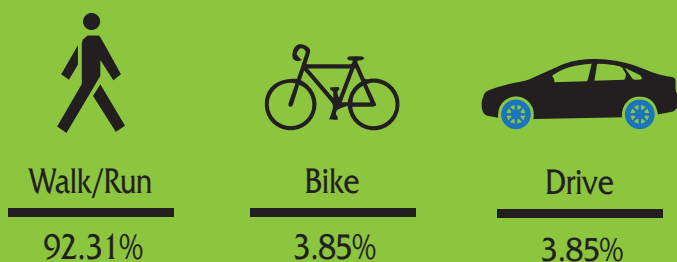
How often do you visit the park? What time of day do you most often visit?



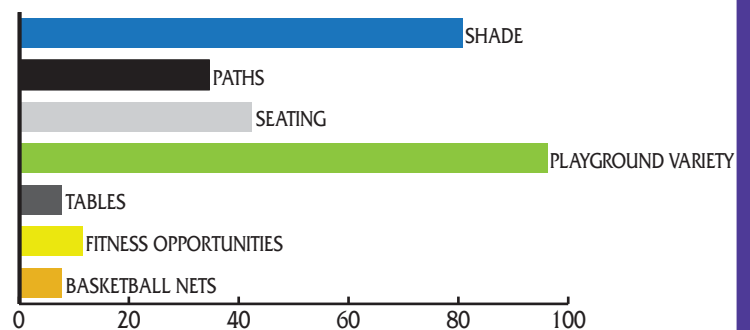
MOST IMPORTANT PARK ACTIVITIES TO PARK USERS

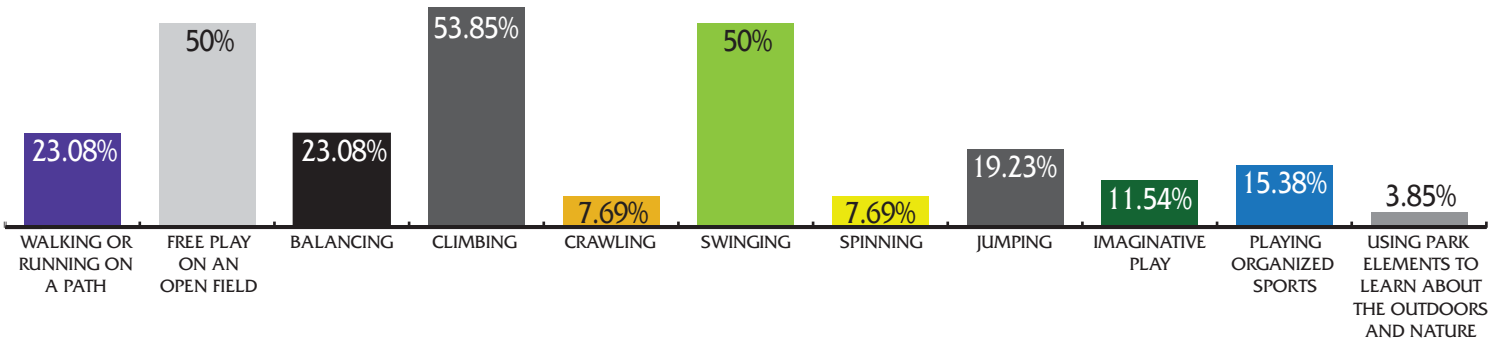

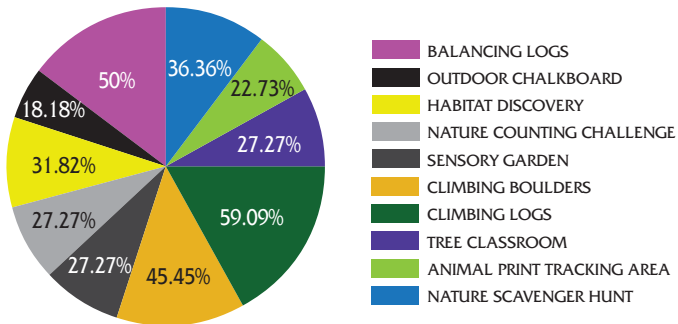

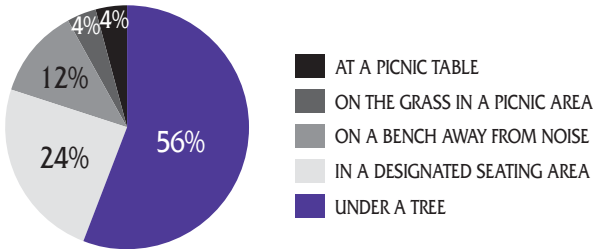

PREFERRED REST & SOCIALIZATION AREAS



IMPORTANT PARK FEATURES TO BE MAINTAINED:

- Slides, swings, a variety of play equipment for younger and older kids
- 2 bays of swings
- Large trees, an open field for sports, bathrooms and an area for an ice rink

ADDITIONAL NOTES AND COMMENTS:

This information was collected via online surveys, at our community open house and from phone calls and emails from the public.

- There is currently not enough shade or places to sit
- I am disappointed that the large old growth trees were recently cut down; they provided lots of great shade
- I would like a full basketball court
- There is currently no path
- I don't like when dogs are off of their leashes
- Older kids take over climbers, and there is no adequate space for younger kids
- I don't like that the neighbourhood uses it as a parking lot
- I dislike sand play area. It's too dirty/messy
- Playground is too close to the baseball diamond and becomes unsafe and unusable during game times
- There is currently minimal equipment
- Plastic slides and swings get too hot and burn
- I would like to see a variety of slides, areas for climbing and free play, a sand area
- No need for the paved pathways. I would prefer a basketball/ball hockey court.
- I would like to see fun colours, more lights, and updated rubberized flooring in the new park
- Less up and down in the play area
- A zip line would be great
- Please install a splash pad
- We need more picnic areas
- More shelter from direct sunlight
- Soft ground around equipment, more seating options
- I would like to see a more natural environment for hands-on exploration
- More equipment is needed for older children such as larger more complex climbing walls and structures, and taller slides
- Please install a paved path (lined with trees/benches)
- I do not like carved wooden chairs, they absorb moisture and if it's damp, they can't be dried easily for play. They also get slivery and seem to wear prematurely.
- Logs and trees are slippery and look dirty and cheap, wood chips are also messy and cheap
- I do not want to see bumpy slow slides
- Open areas to play catch, tag or frisbee would be great
- We want an area to play baseball. Also an area to skateboard or scooter
- We need more complex, large climbing structures and monkey bars with tall slides.
