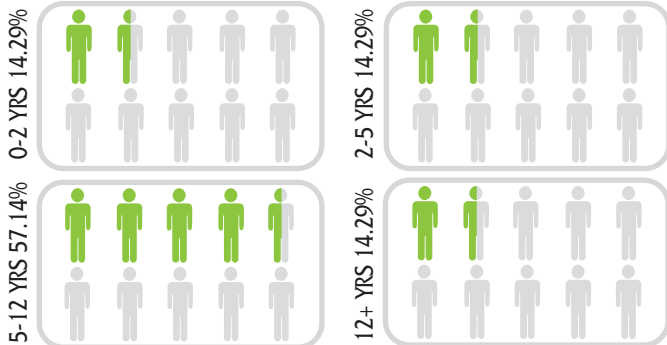

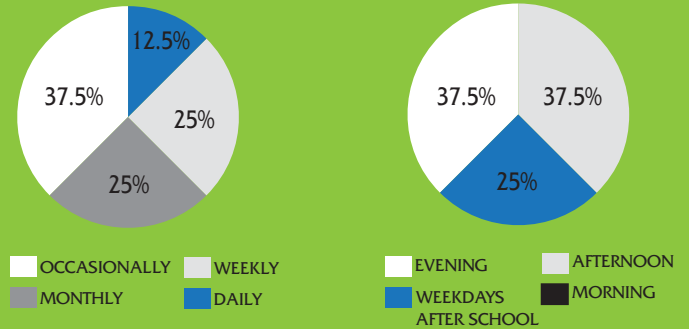


CURRENT PLAYGROUND USER AGE GROUPS



PARK USAGE

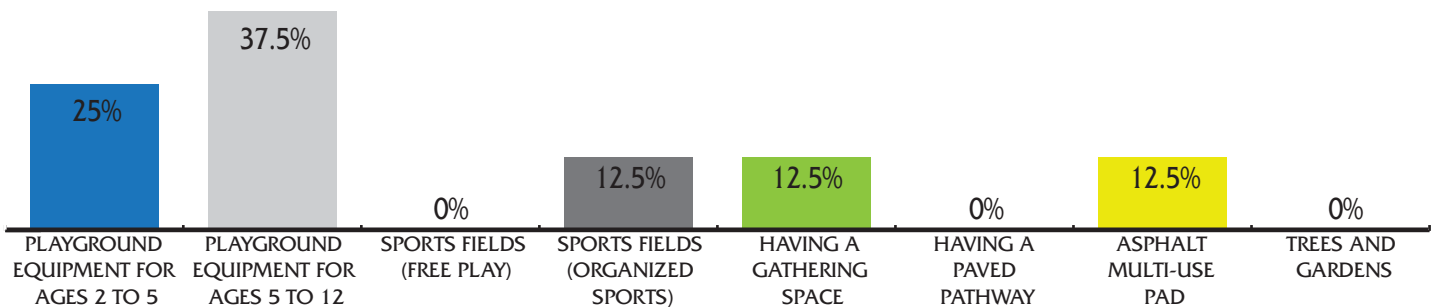
How often do you visit the park? What time of day do you most often visit?



HOW PEOPLE CURRENTLY USE MOOSE PARK



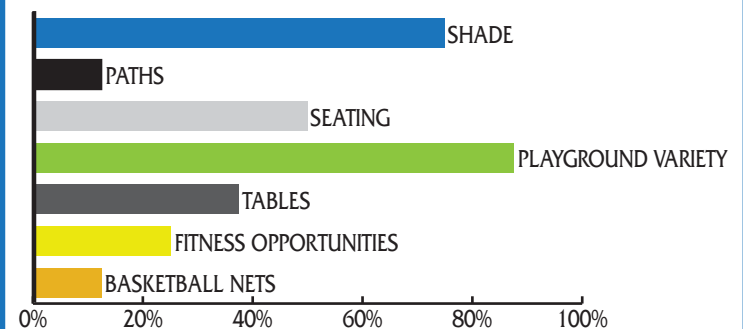
MOST IMPORTANT PARK ACTIVITIES TO PARK USERS

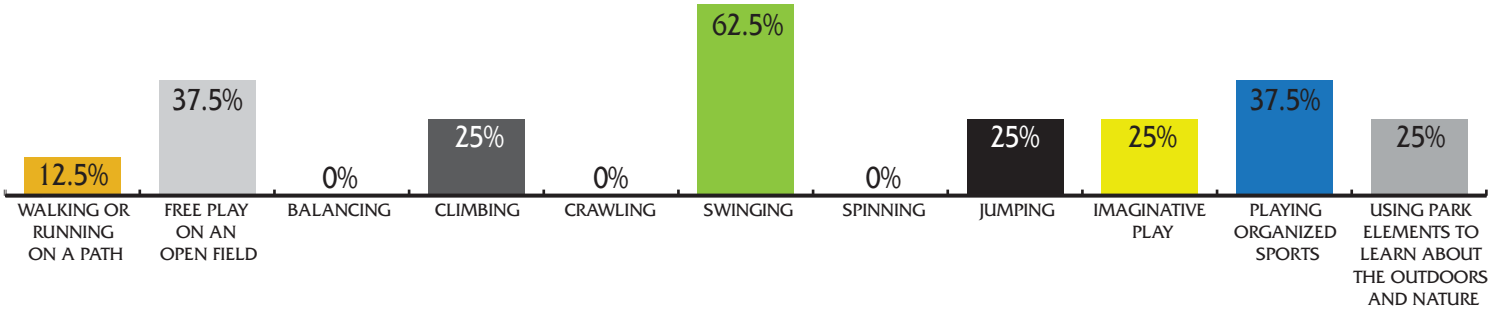

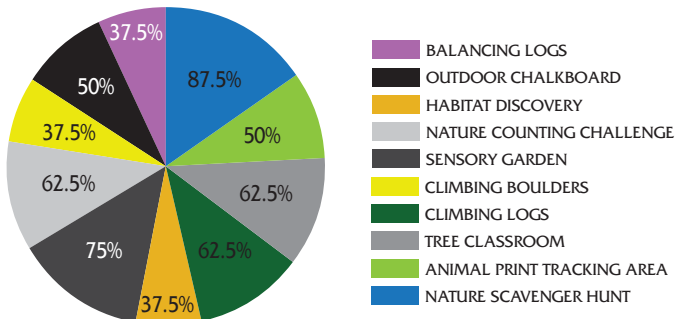

PREFERRED NATURE THEMED ELEMENTS

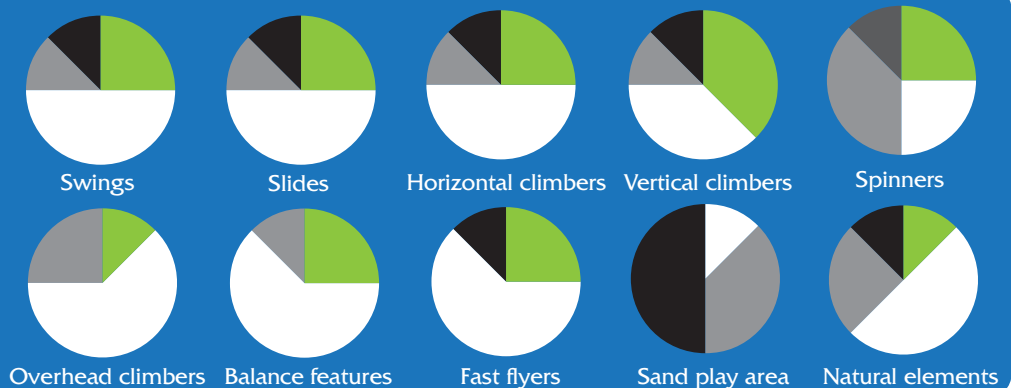


WOULD YOU BENEFIT FROM A ‘NATURE’ THEMED PLAY AREA?

IMPORTANT PARK FEATURES TO BE MAINTAINED:

- 25% of respondents would like the ice rink to stay

CURRENT PARK ISSUES:

- Park needs to be cleaned and maintained more often
- More lighting needed for ice rink
- Very outdated
- Unsafe

FUN FACT:

The multi-use court at Moose Park will be getting full court basketball nets!

ADDITIONAL NOTES AND COMMENTS:

This information was collected via online surveys, at our community open house and from phone calls and emails from the public.

- I would like to see basketball nets, more lighting, toddler playground and big kid playground
- I think some kind of barrier between the playground and the streets would be ideal, even with parents there
- More seating, benches or picnic tables (x2)
- More ice in rink for hockey and have nets already there
- I would not like to see the mature trees be torn down
- Hockey nets, picnic table, a bench to go around big trees so teens can gather and hang out safely
