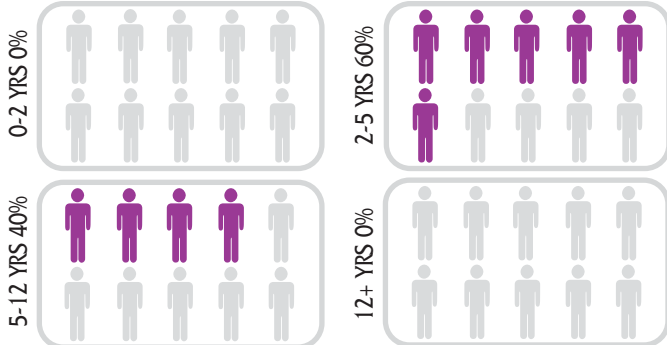

CURRENT PLAYGROUND USER AGE GROUPS

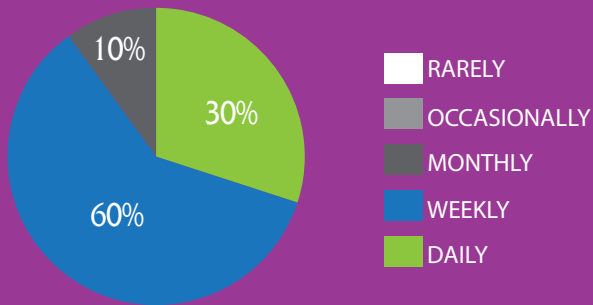


HOW PEOPLE CURRENTLY USE PLEASANT RIDGE PARK

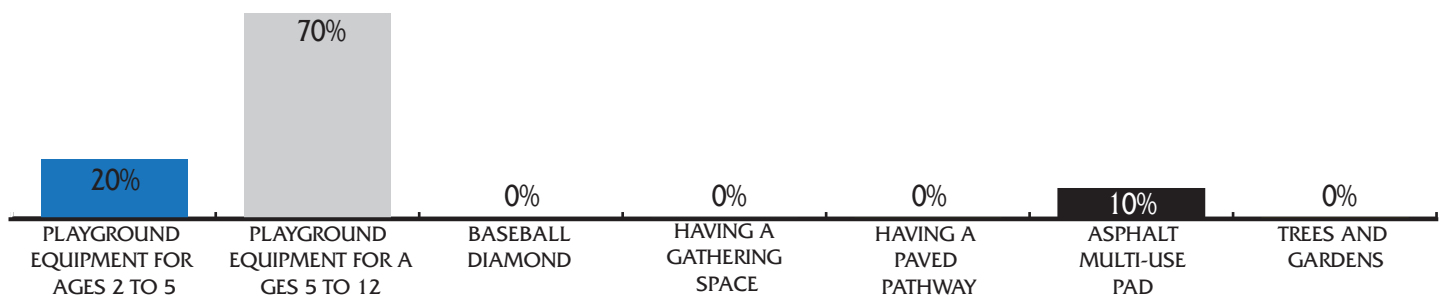

How often do you visit the park?



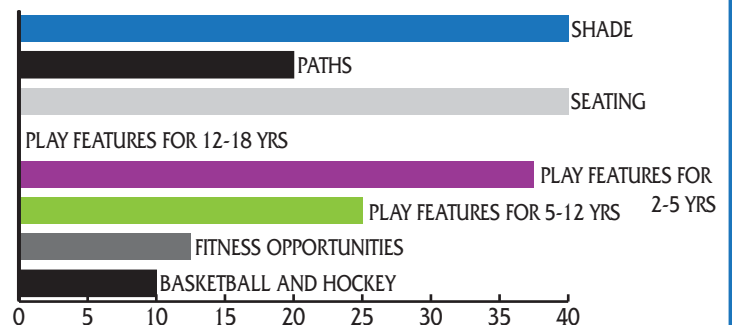

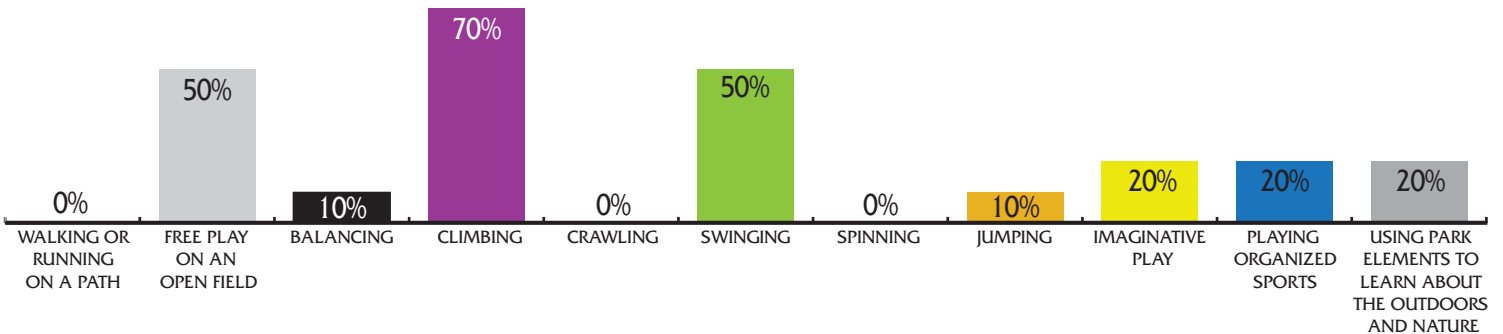

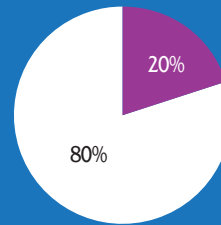


WOULD YOUR CHILDREN ENJOY A SAND PLAY AREA?

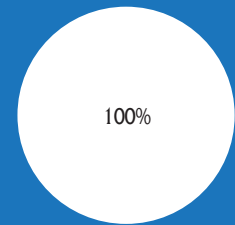


BASEBALL DIAMOND USAGE

Does the community use the baseball diamond?

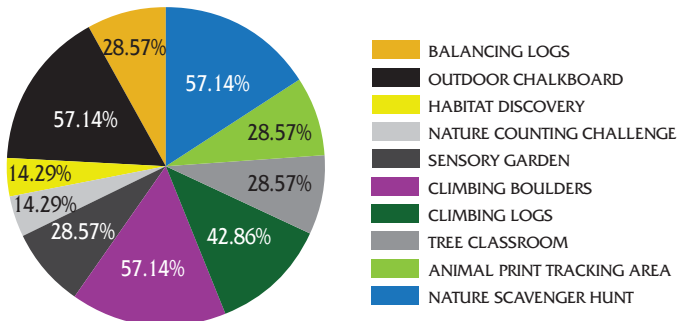


How does the community use the baseball diamond?

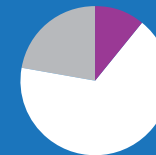
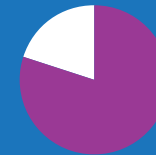
PREFERRED NATURE THEMED ELEMENTS

ADDITIONAL NOTES AND COMMENTS:

This information was collected via online surveys, at our community open house and from phone calls and emails from the public.

- Keep the swings
- Keep the playground in its current location so that the middle area can be used as an ice rink and baseball diamond
- Current park is not wheelchair accessible
- Swings are currently too far from the playground
- The current equipment is not safe
- Outdated
- The field is often rutted in the spring by the city lawnmower. Large branches fall from the mature trees by the playground/swings causing tripping hazards
- New splash pad (x2), repaving of the multi-use sports pad, chess/checker tables, picnic tables, covered gazebo/ pavilion, charcoal barbecue, benches for the multi-use pad
- A place that allows for children aged 1-12 to play on
- Restroom facilities (x2), access ramps from multiple streets (for ease of access with strollers, etc.)
- New playground to be located in the middle of the park (keep it where it is)
- New rock climbing wall
- Baseball, basketball, ice-skating opportunities
