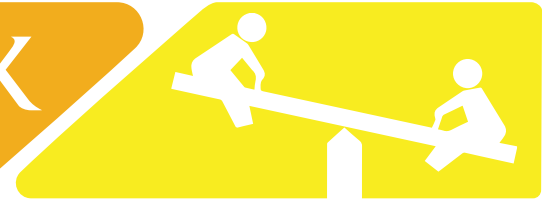

CURRENT PLAYGROUND USER AGE GROUPS

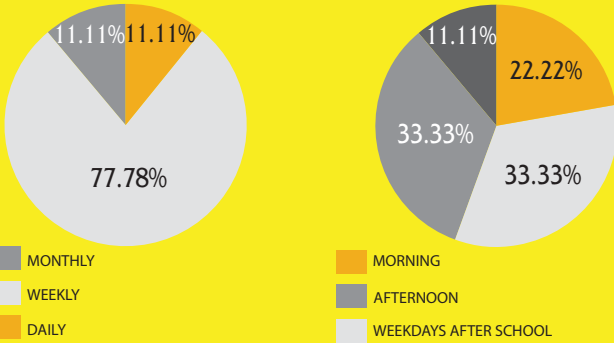


HOW PEOPLE CURRENTLY USE SPRING STREET BUCK PARK

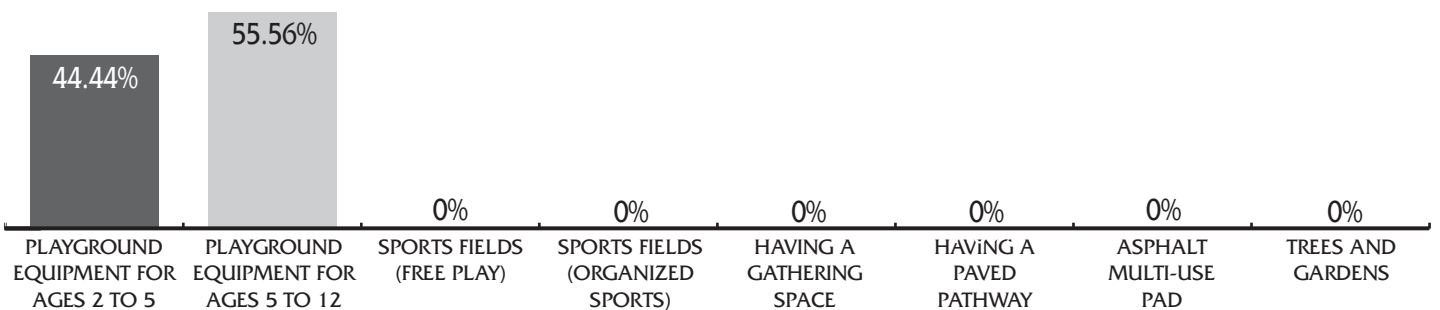


PARK USAGE

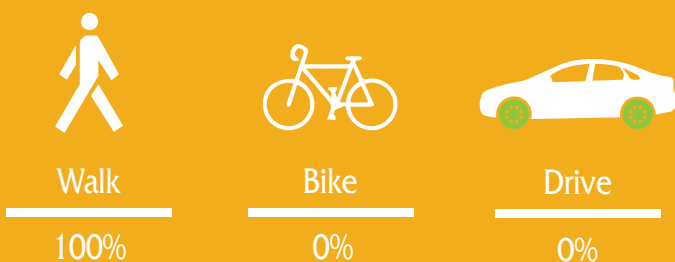
How often do you visit the park? What time of day do you most often visit?



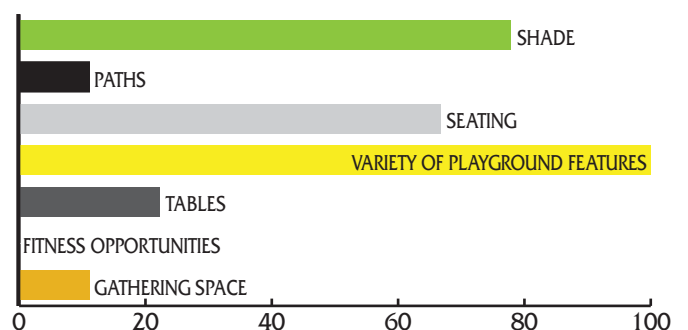
MOST IMPORTANT PARK ACTIVITIES TO PARK USERS

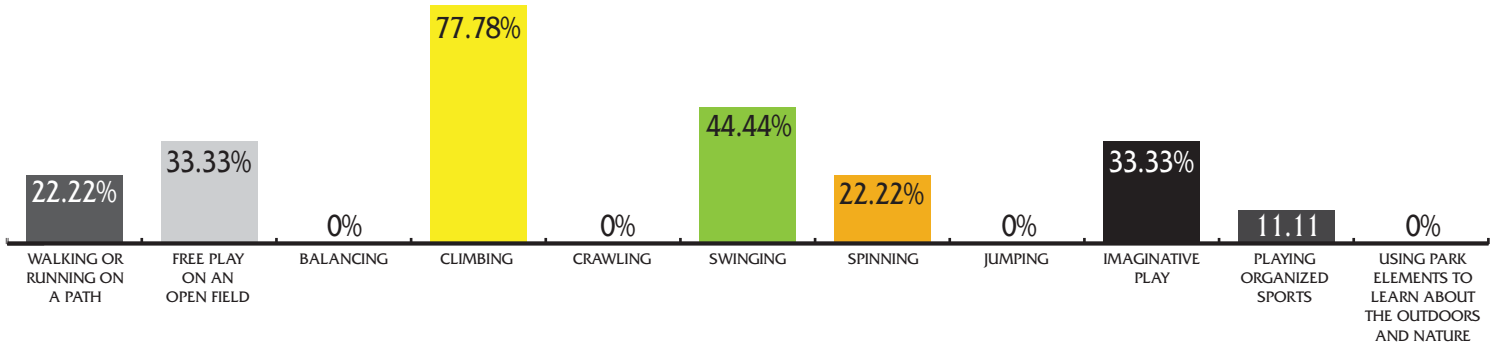

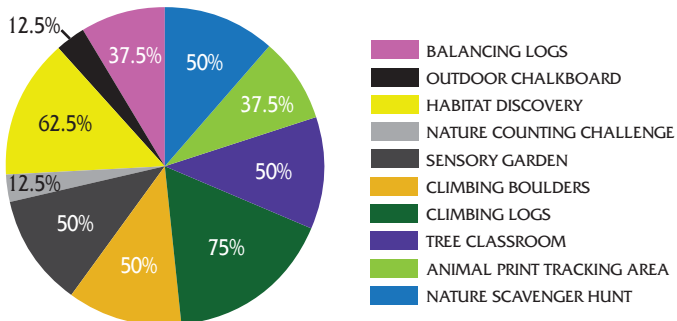

PREFERRED NATURE THEMED ELEMENTS

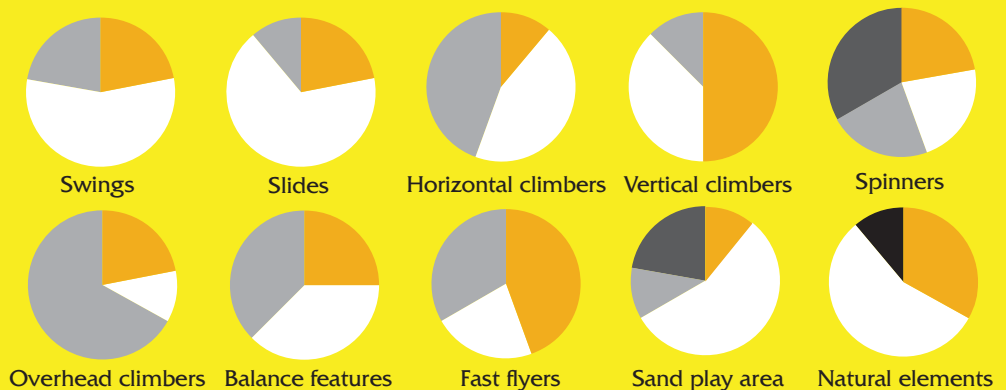


WOULD YOU BENEFIT FROM A 'NATURE' THEMED PLAY AREA?

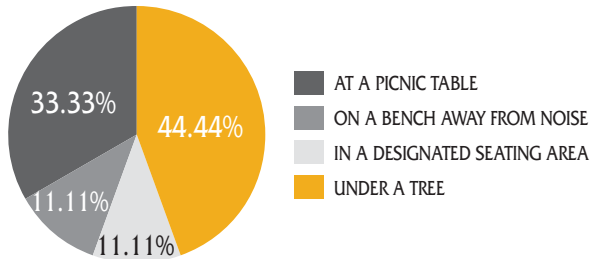
