

Community Safety and Well-Being Framework 2025-2029

The Community Safety and Well-Being Plan is a legislated requirement of all Ontario municipalities under the *Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019* and requires a formal review every four years. The Ministry of the Solicitor General's framework guides these plans to identify local priorities, address systemic issues and promote upstream crime prevention.

The City of Brantford published the [Community Safety and Well-Being Plan 2021-2025](#) in collaboration with community partners from a variety of sectors, including law enforcement, healthcare, post-secondary institutions and human services.

Over the duration of the plan, the community has made significant strides across its priority areas, each of which will continue to be reflected in the updated framework. Additional priorities have been integrated into the framework to better meet the evolving needs and opportunities in the community.

The framework is organized into three categories:

Community Priorities

Areas where the provincial and federal governments maintain primary oversight and responsibility to address the issue. The primary role of the municipality within these areas is to bring together community experts to develop local plans, create visibility for the issue and advocate to upper levels of government for needed resources and solutions.

Strengthen local systems to increase access to affordable, nutritious food.



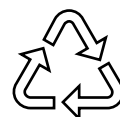
Substance Use and Mental Health

Municipal Focus Areas

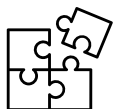
Areas where the municipality is best positioned to lead based on its mandate, scope and direct services.
