

## **2020 CITY BUDGET PROCESS**

On December 9, 2019 the Estimates Committee voted to recommend the 2020 City Budget to City Council resulting in a average residential tax impact of 2.4% inclusive of the capital levy, and amounting to an average residential tax increase of \$76.62.

The 2020 City Budget will be considered by Brantford City Council at a Special Meeting on Wednesday, December 18, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Brantford City Hall (100 Wellington Square, Brantford).

Consistent with the City's Taxpayers Bill of Rights, members of the public are invited to appear as a Delegation at this Special Council Meeting prior to the adoption of the final budget. Persons wishing to appear as a Delegation are required to complete and submit a Delegation Request Form to the Office of the City Clerk no later than 9:00 am on the day of the meeting (December 18th).



# **Protect Water Pipes** from Freezing

Extreme cold temperatures can cause water pipes inside the house to freeze. Plumbing within a basement or unheated areas of a building can freeze if not properly insulated from the extreme cold. This can happen due to drafts or broken or open windows. Water can also freeze where plumbing runs through uninsulated areas within drywall or crawl spaces.

# **Tips on Prevention:**

- Maintain a minimum room temperature of 12 degrees Celsius (55 degrees Fahrenheit) where the water service comes into your home- even when you are on vacation.
- Seal air leaks in your home and garage, including repair of cracked or broken windows.
- Vulnerable sections of plumbing in uninsulated areas may need to be warmed with a heat lamp or space heater.
- Apply a sleeve of foam insulation to exposed plumbing located on exterior walls or in cold rooms of your home such as crawl spaces, cold cellars, basements, attics, storage rooms, and garages.
