

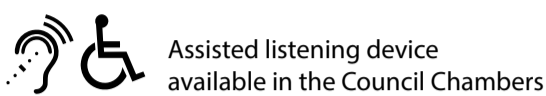

PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE CANNABIS PRODUCTION AND PROCESSING FACILITIES

Amendments To City Zoning Bylaw 160-90 & COUNTY ZONING BYLAW 61-16 – (File No. PZ-06-18)

The City of Brantford will be hosting a Public Information Centre for City Initiated Zoning By-law Amendments. Please see details on the proposed draft amendment below:

Application PZ-06-18 involves City Initiated Amendments to City of Brantford Zoning By-law No. 160-90 and Brant County Zoning By-law No. 61-16 which applies to the former County lands (now in the City). These amendments intend to define "Cannabis Production and Processing Facilities" within both By-laws. The following changes are proposed:

Former County Lands:

- Cannabis Production and Processing Facilities are currently permitted in agricultural areas in the former County lands.
- Once defined, the intent is to remove Cannabis Production and Processing Facilities as a permitted use from these agricultural areas.

City Lands:

- Cannabis Production and Processing Facilities are currently permitted in the Industrial (M2) Zone.
- The intent is to continue to permit the facilities in the M2 Zone, but only within certain employment areas as per the accompanying map.
- Reduced parking and loading regulations and also being considered.
