The City of Brantford, Parks and Recreation Department intends to control vegetation in cracks and crevices in hard surfaces along the following areas: Sidewalks, paved boulevards and traffic islands within the City of Brantford using the herbicide EcoClear Fast Acting Weed and Grass Killer (Acetic acid) Registration No. 25528 or Finalsan Concentrate (Ammonium soap of fatty acids) Registration No 29017 under the *Pest Control Products Act* (Canada) Commencing on 06/24/19 weather permitting, and ending 10/26/19.

The City of Brantford Parks and Recreation Department intends to control vegetation along guardrails and medians throughout the City of Brantford. Applications of a non-selective herbicide know as Round Up Weather Max with Transorb 2 Technology Liquid Herbicide. Registration Number 27487 under the *Pest Control Products Act* (Canada) active ingredient Glyphosate (present as potassium salt) will be applied commencing on June 24, 2019 weather permitting and ending August 31, 2019.
