The study is being conducted in accordance with the approved requirements for a Schedule "B" project as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association (MEA) Municipal Class EA document (October 2000, as amended 2015), which is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.

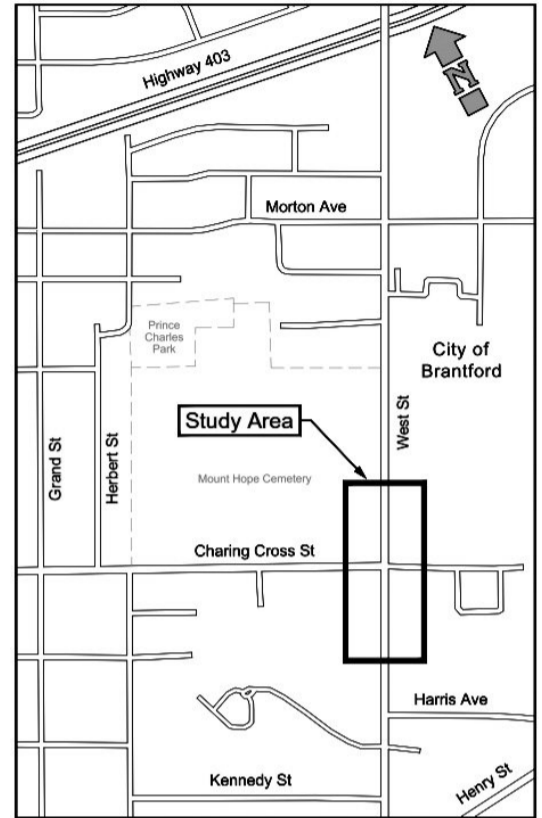
