TAXICAB LICENSING – TARIFF CARD CPI ADJUSTMENT

On June 26, 2018, City Council adopted amendments to Chapter 327 of the City of Brantford Municipal Code – Taxicab Licensing, which provided for tariff adjustments to be made annually in September, based on the Ontario Consumer Price Index (CPI).

An Ontario CPI adjustment of 2% to the meter rate on the tariff card will take effect **September 23, 2019**.

Tariff	Base Rate	Per / km	1km	5km
Current Tariff	\$3.50	\$0.107 Per 1/20th km	\$5.53	\$14.09
Tariff as of September 23rd, 2019	\$3.57	\$0.109 Per 1/20th km	\$5.64	\$14.37
