### Notice of Project Road Resurfacing on Ballantyne Drive (Sherwood Drive to Spalding Drive)

As part of our ongoing efforts to maintain and improve our infrastructure, The City of Brantford, through its contractor, Associated Paving and Materials Limited, will be resurfacing Ballantyne Drive. The project will also include construction of new dedicated bike lanes. The work is scheduled to start in August and will be completed by the end of the month, weather permitting.

Please be aware that Ballantyne Drive will be closed to all traffic during the work. Cyclists should note the posted detour route along the existing road and trail network, set up to bypass the construction zone.
