2020-2021 Windrow Snow Removal Registration

The City of Brantford is now accepting applications for the 2020-2021 Windrow Snow Removal Program. Residents 65 years of age or older, and persons with disabilities or medical conditions can apply for the City's assistance with snow windrows. Snow windrows are the portion of snow at the end of the driveway created after the road is plowed.

You are eligible for the program if you:

- are a resident 65 years of age or older and/or a person with a disability or medical condition
- are a resident of the City of Brantford and owner of the property
- have no person under the age of 65 and/or who is capable of removing snow living at your residence

Both new and renewal applicants can now apply online at www. brantford.ca/WindrowApplication

If you are applying for the first time and are unable to apply online, you must complete the Snow Windrow Removal Application and submit by mail or place in the drop box at 100 Wellington Square, no later than December 1, 2020.
