## PUBLIC MEETING

### Notice of Public Information Centre St. James St. and Albion St. Road, Sewer and Watermain Reconstruction

As part of the ongoing efforts by the City of Brantford to maintain and improve municipal infrastructure, St. James Street (Brant Avenue to Pearl Street) and Albion Street (Bedford Street to Henrietta Street) have been approved for reconstruction in 2020. The project will include the following improvements:

- Replacement of the existing watermain, including servicing to property line
- Replacement of the existing sanitary sewer, including servicing to property line
- Replacement of the existing storm sewer
- Replacement of the asphalt roadway, driveway approaches, curbs, boulevards and sidewalks
- Surface drainage upgrades

Traffic and parking by-laws will also be reviewed as part of the project. Changes to speed limit, lane configurations, on-street parking, and/or line paintings will be proposed on certain streets.

In advance of construction, the public is invited to attend a Public Information Centre (PIC) for an opportunity to review the construction plans. The PIC has been arranged for:
