St. Paul Avenue Road, Watermain, Storm and Sanitary Sewer Reconstruction Virtual PIC

The City of Brantford will be fully reconstructing St. Paul Avenue from Brant Avenue to St. George Street.
The construction will be split into two phases consisting of the following sections:

1. St. Paul Avenue (Terrace Hill Street to St. George Street)

 Construction will commence in spring of 2021 and is expected to be completed in fall 2021

2. St. Paul Avenue (Brant Avenue to Terrace Hill Street)

 Construction is scheduled for spring 2022 and is expected to be completed in fall 2022
