
Mohawk Lake and Mohawk Canal Cleanup and Rehabilitation Project- Design Update

Background

The City of Brantford (the City) completed a Functional Master Drainage and Restoration Study (the Study) as part of the Mohawk Lake and Mohawk Canal Cleanup and Rehabilitation Project. Through (the Study), the City identified rehabilitation measures to address accumulated sediment and opportunities/recommendations to improve the environmental quality and protect and enhance its future in our community.

The following documents were prepared and completed as part of this Study: A Subwatershed Stormwater Plan, an Environmental Assessment Report in accordance with the Schedule B of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) process, and a Master Plan Report.

Subsequently, the design works are being undertaken for the following priority projects of the Environmental Assessment Report:

- An off-line wet pond in Shallow Creek Park which will divert low flows from Shallow Creek for water quality treatment
- The retrofit of the west Mohawk Canal (between Shallow Creek Park and Murray Street) to include improvements for water quality
