Schedule 'B' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment for West Street and Charing Cross Street Intersection Improvements

The Study Background

In 2019, the City of Brantford initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study to identify improvements to the intersection of West Street and Charing Cross Street. A Public Information Center (PIC) was held on June 19, 2019, to share the preliminary preferred design for the intersection improvements. Following this PIC, the Study Team prepared the Project File Report to document the planning and decision-making process for this project.

The City is issuing this notice to inform the public, Indigenous Nations, government agencies, and interested stakeholders about the resumption of the Study. In the coming months, the Study Team will finalize the Project File Report and make it available on the project website for review by interested parties.
